## **English**

This term we are developing our writing and speaking and listening skills through writing a persuasive narrative based upon the Iceland Orangutan advert

We will also have sessions revising the main genres of writing and focusing on spelling, grammar and punctuation skills.

Reading is still a priority for this term so please continue to read regularly with your children at home and discuss what you have read together.

#### Maths

We will cover topics, including fractions, decimals, percentages, measurement and geometry. We will also cover time, probability and shape and space. We are also focusing on mental maths this term and how we can use known number facts to speed up other methods.

## Geography

We will be looking at where rainforests are in the world and how they have changed over time. We will be looking at different terrains and how they are used.

Our time in the learning zone will enable the children to spend lots of time revising and preparing for SATS. We will also be collecting, evaluating and presenting information.
