Communication and Language

We will continue to develop our

speaking and listening skills in our

provision. We will focus on giving

explanations, asking questions and

answering questions from others

appropriately.

Physical Development

Continuing from last term, the children are expected to change for PE independently. We will be focusing on fine motor skills and ensuring our handwriting is readable and our pencil control is anticlockwise when we are writing.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will continue to build independence, self-confidence and social skills. This term we are focusing on explaining our feelings and extending this to how our actions make others feel.

The children are continuing to show great enthusiasm for their learning and we will continue to follow the children's interests and allow them to take the lead on their own learning.

Expressive Arts & Design

As always, children will have the opportunity to be creative through art, music or role play. We will continue to focus on constructing for a particular purpose. Children will also have the opportunity to use the Ipads to take photographs and Mrs Pickering will be thinking about recording and following music.

Maths

We will continue to consolidate
our number knowledge for
numbers 0 - 20. We will
concentrate on subtraction, using
objects and pictures to take away.
We will also be thinking about 3D
shapes, measure (by comparing
size and distance) and money.

Literacy

We will continue to learn new sounds with a particular focus on special friend sounds and using them when reading and writing words.

We will be reading a variety of stories and books related to the children interests and write for a variety of purposes.

Understanding of the World

The children will have plenty of hands on practical opportunities to investigate and explore the natural world.

We will continue to follow the children's interests focusing on animals and their habitats from lions to lady birds!
