Year 3	
Topic	History focuses
Education	<u>Study beyond 1066: Victorians</u> Focus on education in the Victorian times e.g. changes in education, rules, compare and contrast education today
Homelessness	<u>Study beyond 1066: Tudors</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Monarchy – Henry VIII and his wives, links to Doncaster</li><li>• Religion – Catholic, Church of England, protestant</li><li>• Elizabeth I reign</li></ul>
Fair Trade	Anglo Saxons <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Focus on Legal systems, law and justice</li></ul>
Pollution	<u>The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain</u>

During Year 3, children should have experience of the following historical skills:

- Place things on a timeline
- Use dates and terms related to unit of study
- Find out about every day life of people
- Compare with life today
- Distinguish between different sources e.g. compare different versions of the same story
- Begin to use a library and internet for research
- Use a range of sources e.g. videos, textbooks, photographs, artefacts
