#### Literacy

In Literacy, we will be focusing on narrative aspects, creating a character description and a setting description based on the book 'Cloud Tea Monkeys'.

We will revisit previously taught grammar terminology and skills in this first half term to ensure that sentences make sense and are spelt and punctuated accurately.

#### **Maths**

In Maths, we will remain teaching with a mastery approach to Maths, creating solid foundations in place value, before moving on to addition and subtraction.

Please try and create opportunities to practice times tables with your child as these will help in Maths every day! By the end of Year 4, children should be able to recall multiplication facts up to  $12 \times 12$ .

#### Science

We will focus our science this half term on the topic, 'animals including humans'. This includes the human digestive system, teeth and their functions and understanding how food chains work.

# **World Hunger**

#### PE

In PE, we will be developing our ball and team skills through a range of games.

#### **Philosophy**

In our P4C lessons, we will be tackling current issues regarding E-Safety, world hunger and other world news.

#### <u>Music</u>

We will be using a music program which will introduce us to lots of new instruments and rhythms.

#### <u>Art</u>

This term, we are focusing on Michael Angelo. We will be studying how Michael Angelo used sculpture to represent the human form. We will use clay to create our own models of hands in his style.

#### **Homework**

This term, the homework grid will have a range of activities relating to our theme of 'World Hunger'. We encourage children to complete an activity which directly links to our learning that week.

The children will be rewarded with points when they hand in their book.

### Geography

We will be starting the year by developing our atlas skills to locate countries which suffer from chronic hunger.
