Create a rainforest collage.

Research Carl Linnaeus, what was he famous for?

Create your own unique animal taking inspiration from the rainforest and write a description of it.

Create a soundscape to represent the rainforest.

Draw and label the different layers of the rainforests. Look at the animals living in each layer and see how they have adapted to life there.

Research the artist Henry Rousseau. What type of art did he create?

Create your own classification key for a group of rainforest animals.

Research tribes who live in the rainforest. Watch some videos and write a day in the life.

Listen to rainforest sounds and note down what you can hear. How does it make you feel?

Locate the world's rainforests on a map.

Create a colour pallet of rainforest colours in whichever medium you prefer.

Create a key diagram to identify different species of penguins. Consider what makes them unique.

Design and create your own set of Top Trumps cards for rainforest animals.

Design a poster on word about climate change.

Research and list the human and physical characteristics of the rainforests.

Choose an animal from the rainforest and print it off. Chop the image in half, stick it on some paper and attempt to draw the other half. Can you make it symmetrical?

Research microhabitats and then go out into the garden to search for them. Take photos of the ones you find.

What is deforestation? How has this impacted on climate change?

Film a persuasive advert against the use of palm oil products.

Research the aborigine people of Australia. How are their lives different to ours?

Build a suspension bridge out of materials in your home.

Research the different animal classifications. Choose a selection of animals and classify them. What is the difference between vertebrates and invertebrates?

What is palm oil? Why is its production destroying the rainforest? What does it appear as on labels.

Create an interactive power point presentation on the rainforest.

Research the Incas, Mayans and the Aztecs. All of these tribes used to live in the rainforest. Compare the similarities and differences.

Evaluate your bridge and its effectiveness/style.

Design and create your own habitat for an insect/small mammal and put it in your garden. Did any creatures settle?

Look around your house and locate items that contain palm oil. How many palm oil items do you own?

Record sounds in your back garden or at the park. How do these sounds compare to the rainforest?

Watch some episodes of either Planet Earth or A life on our planet by David Attenborough.
