Maths

- This half term we are going to be exploring fractions. We will be adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator within one whole, for example, $\frac{5}{7} + \frac{1}{7} = \frac{6}{7}$.
- We will also be comparing and ordering unit fractions, and fractions with the same denominators

DT

We will be creating different designs using recyclable materials, including plastic bottles.

Science

Our science topic this half term is all about light. Children will recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light and to notice that light is reflected from surfaces. We will also be exploring shadows.

PSHE

Our Jigsaw theme this half term is "Relationships". We will look at what it means to be a global citizen and how our actions can impact on others. We will also explore keeping safe, discussing different scenarios and who to go to if you don't feel safe.



PLASTIC POLLUTION

Computing

We will begin by looking at E-Safety, learning how we can keep safe on the internet. We will then explore data handling.

Literacy

Our purpose in writing this half term is to write a persuasive letter to Boris Johnson about Plastic Pollution. We will be looking at how plastic pollution is impacting our environment, with a specific focus on marine questions. Through our sequence we will look at different persuasive techniques as we try and persuade Boris Johnson to make changes that will further reduce plastic pollution

Reading

This half term we will be reading 'Stig of the Dump', as part of our novel story. We will be focusing on a variety of different skills, such as finding evidence from the text to support our answers and opinions.

History

We will learn about the Romans and the impact they had on Britain. We will be comparing the Roman era to Britain today.
