English

This term we will be focusing on Shakespeare's Macbeth. The children will have an immersive experience, where they have an opportunity to be part of Macbeth. From this, children will create a letter of response to Lady Macbeth. Later in the term, children will produce a narrative based on Macbeths experiences after he becomes King.

Art

This term we will be focusing on art from Western Africa, looking specifically at sculpture and painting. The children will have the opportunity to create their own headdress.

DT

Our DT supports our refugee topic; we will be looking at foods from around the world. The children will cook their very own stir fry and complete a food analysis.

Maths

For this term, we will be focusing on number and place value. The children have great number knowledge; we will be building on this through the year 6 curriculum. As part of our maths curriculum, we will also be focusing on arithmetic skills, where we consolidate the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

Please encourage your children to practice their times tables.

History

We shall be teaching history separately this year and our focus is on War. This half term we shall be looking at WW1 – the key events, people, causes and how it ended.

Computing

For our IT we will be focussing on coding. We will look at repetition commands, 'if' statements and variables before designing our own game that simulates a physical system!

This term we will be learning to be compassionate global citizens. We will look at the refugee crisis globally and reflect upon common opinions and how the world needs to change.

Refugees

Science

This term we shall be covering the topic of electricity, where we will be looking at where electricity comes from, electrical symbols and building our own circuits.

P.E.

This term we be taking part in FLEX dance, where an outside provider will come and teach us a dance sequence, that we will perform at the end of term.

Geography

We will be looking at the key countries that refugees come from and where the largest camps are located; placing them on a world map and comparing them. We shall also be ensuring that we can name and identify the 7 continents and 5 oceans as well as the major seas.

Throughout this term we will be focusing on Atlas skills and mapping. This will support us in identifying key countries and relating them to their flags and topographical features.
