

Year 2 Spring 2

Literacy

In Literacy we will be developing our creative writing skills. Our stimulus will be the fairy tale 'Hansel and Gretel'. Children will explore a non-chronological report about witches as well as coming up with their own alternative ending for the tale.

Science

This half term, the children will be researching different plants and learning about what a plant needs to grow healthily and what effects changing seasons has on plant growth. We will also be learning about the scientist Tim Smit.

Theme

Over the half term, our theme will look at Foodbanks. We will look at what one is, what they do, how they help us and how we can support them.

Maths

This half term we will be learning all about fractions, time and shape. The children will be working out a fraction of an amount. Children will then learn about time through increments of 5. They then will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes.

History/Geography

In History, we will be learning and researching about the Tudors. Throughout our history we will be looking at who the Tudors were, what happened in the Tudor Period and who ruled the Tudors.

In Geography, we will be learning about climates and where they are in relation to the equator as well as physical and human geography.

PE

This half term we will be learning about athletics in PE.
