Communication and Language

We are continuing to use a floor book with our children, each week we add photos of the children and what they have been learning. In small groups the children are becoming really confident to share their thoughts and ideas about what they can see and what they have learned. This half term we are learning 'Lifecycle: from Egg to Chicken' and other animal stories.

Expressive Arts & Design

We are continuing to focus on supporting the children to take their time and pay close attention to detail when they draw, paint and write and the supporting them to review their work and see if or how they could make it even better. We will be working on some whole class projects for our Summer Fair and our animal topic.

Physical Development


Our Sports day was a fantastic success and each and every child made us extremely proud of how hard they tried when things were tricky and not easy for them. We are focusing this half term on ensuring that every child is as independent in self-care as they possibly can be - hats, coats, shoes, toileting and handwashing. We are also keen to ensure every child has the best pen grip that they can before they move on from us. We are proud of the progress that every child has made in this over the year. particularly enjoying digging with the long-handled spades. These activities will support gross motor development which in turn will support the children to have good pencil grip and control.

Maths

We will continue to practice counting, number recognition and forming numbers every day as we do our register. We will be focusing this half term on patterns, recognising errors in patterns and subitising. Many children are able to subitise small numbers such as 1, 2 and 3, so we will be looking at different ways of making 4 and 5 so that children can instantly recognise when there are four or five objects rather than having to count them.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We are placing a huge focus this half term on the children communicating with each other using full sentences particularly around sharing and taking turns, for example, can I have a turn please? Will you share with me please? Thank you, that's kind. If you could also encourage this at home too that would be fantastic! This half term will see the children go to their next class for their transition day - something I'm sure they are all very excited about. The Foundation 2 teachers have been popping in the class already for short visits to meet their new children.



Literacy

This half term we will be reading lots books around animals and lifecycles. The children have shown an interest in lots of animals and even in different kinds of animal pool We will read our focused stories in addition to animal books that the children are interested in. They have asked so many interesting questions and so our reading will focus around answering the children's questions.

Understanding of the World

Our children will be learning about their own life cycle as part of our topic this half term. We will also learn about habitats, diets, environments, different countries as we explore our topic this half term.
