This half term will be looking at many different areas of the maths curriculum. We will be exploring measurement, looking at length and perimeter and focusing on converting between different units of measure. We will also be looking at mass and capacity, specifically focusing on knowing the difference between volume and capacity.

Art/DT

Science

Our science topic this half term will continue to be light. We will be focusing on how there are many positives to the sun however we must also be safe when we are out in the sun. We will be creating a positive 'keeping safe in the sun' to give everyone information on how to enjoy the sun safely.

PSHE

Our Jigsaw theme this half term is "Changing Me". Within our PSHE lessons this half term we will be talking about how our body changes as we get older and how we can positively cope with this change.

Literacy
