

Year 2 Autumn 2

Literacy

In Literacy we will be developing our creative writing skills. Our stimulus in Literacy is 'It's a no money day' by Kate Milner. We will be creating our own diary recount, describing the experience of visiting a foodbank from a child's perspective.

PE

This half term we will be focusing on fundamental skills, whilst working together to promote team skills. PE sessions for both classes will be on a Friday each week.

Please send children with their kit on a Monday and it can remain in school until Friday as we have 2 PE sessions a week.

Reading

Please read at home as much as you can to develop the children's love of reading. Books need to be returned to school in their plastic wallets on a Monday and placed in the box in their classroom. Books will be changed and sent back out on a Tuesday.

Science

This half term we will be continuing with our focus on animals including humans, looking at basic needs. Later in the term, we will focus on the scientist Louis Pasteur, looking at what he discovered.

Theme

Over the half term, our theme will look at Foodbanks. We will look at what one is, what they do, how they help us and how we can support them.

Maths

This half term we will be learning how to apply addition and subtraction skills by adding and subtracting two-digit numbers. Later in the term, we will be focusing on multiplication, looking specifically at 2s, 5s and 10s.

History/Geography

In History, we will be learning and researching about the Romans. Throughout our history unit, we will be looking at who the Romans were and what impact they had on Britain.

In Geography, we will be learning about our local environment, exploring where our local food sources are in Wheatley.

Spellings/Home

learning – Spellings and reading books will be sent home weekly. Please could you practise reading and spellings with your child as often as possible- Thank you.

Art/DT

In Art, we will be continuing our work learning about Giuseppe Arcimboldo, focusing on portraits. In DT, we will be creating a fruit salad using DT skills: cutting, peeling and grating.
